




Introduction

Skin biopsies are an essential diagnostic tool and, when performed properly, can contribute significantly to positive diagnostic and treatment outcomes.

We at BDL provide complete dermatopathology service from skin punch biopsy service in our clinic upon request by dermatologists to receiving skin biopsy samples to process and interpret. We are dedicated to the highest standards in the field of inflammatory dermatoses and neoplastic dermatopathology.

Skin biopsy procedure is performed in our dedicated, fully equipped clinic, performed by our experienced dermatopathology board certified physician. The sample is immediately processed on-site and a detailed report is issued in a timely manner.





When is skin punch biopsy needed?

Skin biopsy can be the only way to reach a definitive diagnosis. Many skin dermatoses overlap clinically or become refractory to treatment and a biopsy is required for a specific diagnosis to better design the management. Skin biopsy is also necessary to achieve a definitive diagnosis on neoplastic lesions in order to adequately plan surgical excisions.

How long does it take to receive a skin punch biopsy result?

On average, results are released within 48 hours of the procedure to allow for prompt treatment. Occasionally, a sample requires additional specialized ancillary testing that can take up to 3-4 working days.

Who will read the skin punch biopsy?

All skin cases are read by a highly qualified, board certified dermatopathologist having over 10 years experience in the field. Slide review consultation services and ancillary studies including special stains and immunohistochemistry services are also available.

Is skin punch biopsy safe?

This is a safe, minimally invasive procedure performed under local anesthesia. The procedure implements round-tipped biopsy tool to remove a small core of skin tissue avoiding vital underlying structures to be processed and interpreted for diagnosis. A single stitch might be needed to close the wound.
