

Which cytological preparation method is utilized at BDL?

We offer the ThinPrep[™] liquid-based cytology method, which is preferred for its improved sample quality. This method significantly reduces interference from blood and mucus, lowers the rate of unsatisfactory samples, facilitates ancillary testing, and enhances the detection of abnormalities.

Which PAP test diagnostic system is followed at BDL?

We utilize the Bethesda system for reporting cervical cytology, a standardized system that aids in the clear and actionable interpretation of PAP tests.

How long does it take to receive a result?*

- PAP test: 24 hours
- Biopsy (endometrial/endocervical): 48 hours
- Surgical sample: 5 working days
